

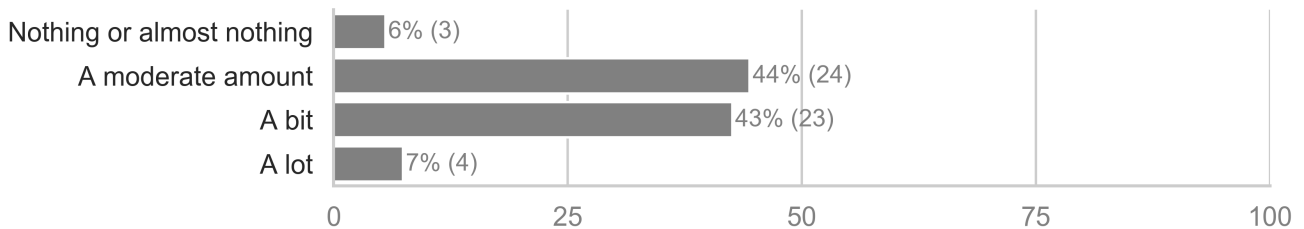
Workshop Provider Report

Below are the post-workshop survey results for the workshop provider. All together, 54 respondents attended 28 workshops given by 35 workshop leaders.

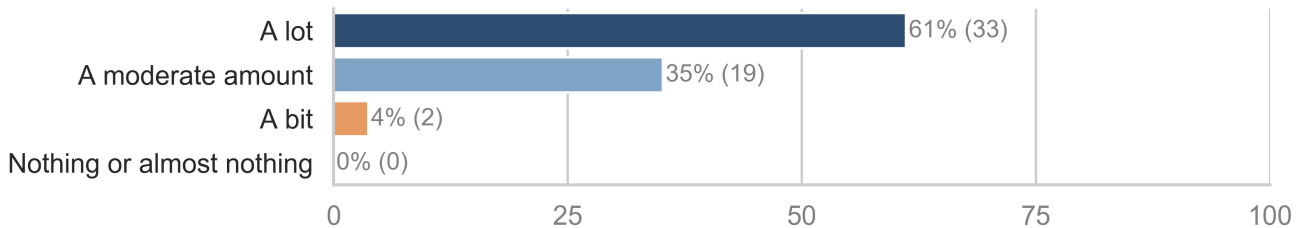
Learning Outcomes and Workshop Content

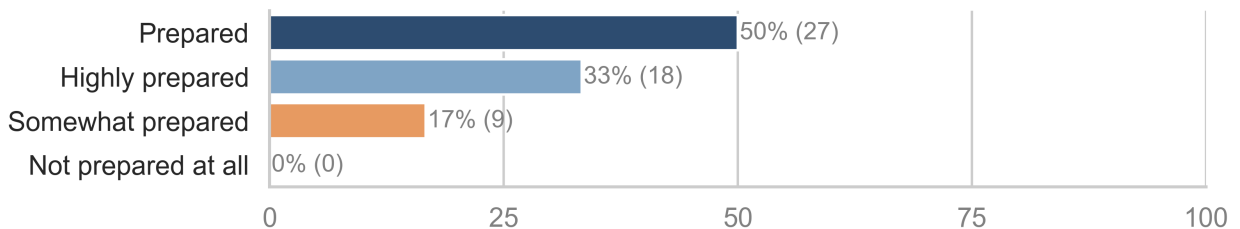
Q10: Before taking part in this workshop, how much did you know about the topic of the workshop?



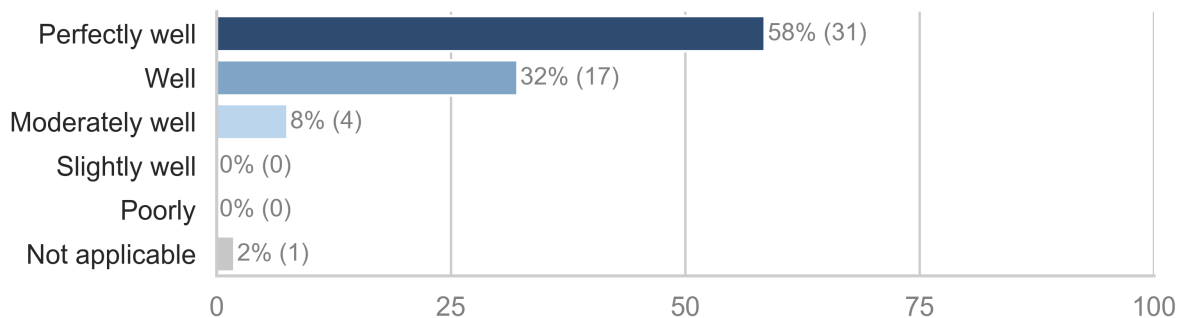
Q11: After taking part in this workshop, how much do you know about the topic of the workshop?
